ernment has taken one more step by introducing the scheme in the secondary schools and junior colleges in the State. The GR states that such sevaks would be appointed for 10 months in each year with the vacation being treated as no work no pay. The salary would be called the honorarium and it ranges from Rs. 2500 to Rs. 3500 per month. A fully qualified junior college teacher with post-graduate degree in second class and training qualification of B.Ed./DHE, would receive Rs. 3500/- per month. There would be one day leave for every two months of service for such teachers which works out to a mere 5 days of paid leave in the entire year. Any leave beyond the 5 day limit would be without pay. All other facilities that the teaching community enjoys are denied to them. The system of appointment would continue for a period of 5 years with 50 months of pay out of 60 months, and then the sevaks would be held eligible for employment as regular teachers. The GR provides the duties to be performed by such sevak which includes all the duties that a teachers is expected to perform apart from 'any other duty' that may be assigned by the Principals/Headmasters and managements of the institutions. This will set at naught the procedure of selection committees, proper selection of suitable candidates, counting of service for placements in higher scales of pay and so on. Teachers all over the State from KG to PG are agitated against the government's action. This is a struggle of the teaching community not for their scales of pay or other economic demands of theirs. It is a struggle of the teaching community for protecting and preserving the profession to which they belong, whose contributions in terms of human capital development is being overlooked.

This house is convinced that the government action in respect of appointing shikshan sevak will spell disaster to the very edifice of education in our state and the damage that is being done today will be irreparable.

This house is of the opinion that, a new united struggle of the teaching community from KG to PG all over the State will be necessary if we have to force the State to see reason and trace back the steps that the

State has taken in the wrong direction.

शुक्रवार, दिनांक २६ मे २००० रोजीच्या नागपूर येथून प्रसिद्ध होणाऱ्या दै.लोकसत्ताच्या 'विदर्भरंग' पुरवणीमध्ये "जुन्या कागदांची नवी रद्दी, नुटाने चालविले आहे तरी काय?" या मथळ्याचा लेख लिहून डॉ. सु.ह.पळसापूरे यांनी संघटनेचे सदस्य या नात्याने अत्यंत बेजबाबदारपणाचे वर्तन केलेले आहे. डॉ. सु.ह. पळसापूरे हे स्वतः संघटनेचे आजिवन सदस्य आहेत. (क्रमांक ८५) त्या अधिकारामध्ये त्यांना नुटाबुलेटीन नियमितपणे मिळते हे त्यांच्या लेखावरून स्पष्ट दिसून येते. संघटनेच्या आमसभेने एकमताने रविवार, दिनांक १९ सप्टेंबर १९९९ रोजी विषय क्रमांक २६२ नव्याने मंजूर केलेल्या ठरावावर त्यांनी केलेली टिका त्यांच्या क्षुद्र बुद्धीचे प्रतिनिधित्व करणारी आहे.

विद्यापीठीय व महाविद्यालयीन शिक्षकांकरिता विद्यापीठ अनुदान आयोगाची वेतनश्रेणी केंद्र शासनाच्या १७ जून १९८७ व २२ जुलै १९८८ च्या आदेशान्वये देण्यात आलेल्या सूचनांसह महाराष्ट्र शासनाने अंमलात आणावयाची असे क्रमांक १ वर नमूद केलेल्या समझोता पत्रान्वये ठरले होते.

(२) नेटसेट ह्या पात्रता परीक्षा विविध माध्यमातून आयोजित करावयाच्या आहेत. महाराष्ट्र शासनाच्या मुळ निर्णयाच्या (२७.२.८९) परिच्छेद ९ मध्ये माध्यमाचा उल्लेख अतिशय स्पष्टपणे नमूद आहे. तो पुढील शब्दात :- “Only those candidates, who, besides fulfilling the minimum qualifications prescribed for the post of a lecturer, Librarian and Physical Education Staff, have qualified in a comprehensive test to be conducted for the purpose will be eligible for appointment. The detailed scheme for conducting the test including its design, the agencies to be employed in the conduct of the test, content, administration etc. will be worked out by the University Grants Commission keeping in view the requirement of the media of instruction followed by the different Universities and Colleges and other relevant considerations.”

(३) २७ फेब्रुवारी १९८९ च्या याच शासननिर्णयामध्ये पुढे “तोवर जुनीच प्रक्रिया चालू राहील” असाही स्पष्ट उल्लेख आहे तो पुढील शब्दात :- “The same procedure should continue to be in operation till it is suitably replaced by the comprehensive test to be prescribed by the University Grants Commission.” विद्यापीठ अनुदान आयोगाने माध्यमासह सर्व तपशील ठरविल्यानंतर जी “निवडीची प्रक्रिया पात्रता परीक्षेसह” येईल ती १९७७ च्या शासन निर्णयांनी विहित केलेल्या “विद्यमान निवड प्रक्रियेला” “सुटेबली रिप्लेसड” करील असे शासन निर्णयात नमूद आहे. विद्यमान व्यवस्था (निवड प्रक्रिया) सुटेबली रिप्लेसड झाली काय? हा आजचा खरा प्रश्न आहे व त्याचे उत्तर १ जानेवारी २००० च्या दरम्यान ती झालेली आहे असे आहे.

(४) नेटसेटबाबत शासनाने पुढे अत्यंत चुकीचे धोरण स्विकारले. “नेट सेट परीक्षा उत्तीर्ण केली असेल तरच ३१ मार्च १९९४ नंतर त्यांना सेवेत ठेवण्यात यावे” असा पहिला हুকूम २ फेब्रुवारी १९९४ च्या शासन पत्रान्वये काढण्यात आला. “३१ मार्च १९९५ पर्यंत नेट सेट परीक्षा उत्तीर्ण न झाल्यास त्यांना सेवामुक्त करा” असा दुसरा आदेश ७ मार्च १९९४ च्या पत्रान्वये देण्यात आला. व मग त्यानंतर “३१ मार्च १९९६ पर्यंत नेट सेट परीक्षा उत्तीर्ण न झाल्यास त्यांना सेवामुक्त करा” असा आदेश २० मार्च १९९४ च्या शासन पत्रान्वये देण्यात आला. परिणियमांनी केलेली व्यवस्था पत्राने मोडून काढण्याच्या या प्रकाराने शेकडो शिक्षकांना गेली अनेक वर्षे अत्यंत मानसिक तणावात काढावी लागली. २ फेब्रुवारी १९९४ ते २० मार्च १९९४ या दोन महिन्यांच्या (धड दोन सुद्धा नव्हे) काळातील उच्च शिक्षण विभागाची ही तीन पत्रे पाहिली म्हणजे या साऱ्या प्रकाराची एकंदर हास्यास्पदता लक्षात येते. विशेष असे की पत्रापत्रीचा हा सारा प्रकार केंद्र शासनाच्या विद्यापीठ अनुदान आयोगाच्या, परिणियमांच्या व समझोत्याच्या विरोधात होता.

(५) “जोपर्यंत आपली पर्यायी व्यवस्था होत नाही, तोपर्यंत सिलेक्शन कमिटीच्या निवड प्रक्रिया फायनल राहिल. इतकेच नव्हे तर “२ वर्षांनंतर त्यांना कन्फर्म करा” असे चान्सलर महोदयांच्या मान्यतेचे स्टॅट्यूट आहेत ... माझे म्हणणे असे आहे की, जी टेस्ट आहे, ती रिक्रुटमेंटची एक वेगळी पद्धत आहे. ती पद्धत जोपर्यंत अंमलात येत नाही तोपर्यंत परिणियमानुसार झालेली रिक्रुटमेंट १०० टक्के लॉफूल आहे. माननीय चान्सलर यांच्या सहीने आपण ते ठरविले आहे, जो २७.२.८९ चा जी.आर काढला त्याप्रमाणे स्टॅट्यूट झालेले आहे. या सर्व अॅडव्हर्टाइजमेंट अॅप्रुव्ह झालेल्या आहेत. नियमाप्रमाणे त्या सर्व रिक्रुटमेंट परफेक्टली लॉफूल अशा झालेल्या आहेत. ज्या दिवशी आपण नवीन व्यवस्था, नवीन अल्टरनेट अरेंजमेंट कराल त्या दिवसापासून ते लागू होईल. सुटेबली रिप्लेसड होईल, अशी खरी गोष्ट आहे. यामध्ये आज सेवेत असलेले जे शिक्षक आहेत त्यांना मुदत वाढवून देण्याचा प्रश्न नाही. त्यांच्या नेमणूकपत्रामध्ये तसे नाही, त्यांना कधी तसे सांगितले नाही, जाहिरातीमध्ये तसे जाहीर केले नाही.... आज सेवेत असलेल्या लोकांना लागू होत नाही. कारण त्यांचे सिलेक्शन लॉफूल आहे, ते कंडीशनल नाही. लॉ-फुली कॉन्स्टीट्युटेड सिलेक्शन कमिटीच्यामार्फत चान्सलरांच्या स्टॅट्यूटप्रमाणे ते रिक्रुट झालेले आहेत. त्यांना कॉम्पीटन्ट अॅथॉरिटीची मान्यता आहे. त्यांना ते लागू होत नाही. सेवेत असलेल्या लोकांना ते लागू करण्याचे आपण या २-४ महिन्यात आदेश काढले ते आपण केंद्रा मागे घेणार असा प्रश्न आहे. याचे माननीय मंत्री महोदय उत्तर देतील काय?” एवढी माहिती विधानपरिषद सभागृहामध्ये ऐकून घेतल्यानंतर विचारलेल्या प्रश्नाला उत्तर देतांना राज्याच्या मा. मुख्यमंत्र्यांनी “यापूर्वी शिक्षक झालेले आहेत आणि त्यांना याची आवश्यकता नाही असे सन्माननीय सदस्य श्री.वी.टी.देशमुख सांगत आहेत. तर ती वस्तुस्थिती असेल तर त्यासंबंधीचा अपवाद करण्याची तयारी राहिल.” असे स्पष्ट आश्वासन गुरुवार दिनांक १७ मार्च १९९४ रोजी सभागृहामध्ये दिल्यानंतर “नेट/सेट परीक्षा उत्तीर्ण करण्याची दिनांक ३१.३.१९९६ ची मुदत या आदेशाद्वारे काढून टाकण्यात येत आहे.” अशी तरतूद असलेला शासन निर्णय निर्गमित करण्यासाठी उच्च व तंत्र शिक्षण विभागाला २१ महिन्यांचा कालावधी लागावा व त्यानंतर सुद्धा मधल्याच दोन वेतनवाढी रोखणे, वरिष्ठ निवड वेतनश्रेणी न देणे या बाबी चालुच रहाव्या ही अत्यंत दुर्दैवाची गोष्ट आहे.

(६) शासनाची ही चुक महाराष्ट्र प्राध्यापक महासंघाने लक्षात आणून दिल्यानंतर “नेट/सेट परीक्षा उत्तीर्ण करण्याची दिनांक ३१.३.१९९६ ची मुदत या आदेशाद्वारे काढून टाकण्यात येत आहे.” असे सांगणारा संदर्भ चार वर नमुद केलेला शासन निर्णय निर्गमित झाला. या शासननिर्णयाबाबत ७ जानेवारी १९९६ रोजीच्या बैठकीमध्ये महाराष्ट्र प्राध्यापक संघाने स्पष्टपणे आपली भूमिका पुढील शब्दात नमुद केली होती :- “नेटसेट बाबत शासनाची भूमिका विद्यापीठ अनुदान आयोगाच्या, तसेच केंद्र शासनाच्या धोरणाशी व महाराष्ट्र शासनाशी महाराष्ट्र प्राध्यापक महासंघाचा जो समझोता झाला त्याच्याशी पूर्णपणे विसंगत होती याचा कबुलीजबाबच या २२ डिसेंबर १९९५ च्या शासन निर्णयाने दिलेला आहे. “नेट/सेट परीक्षा उत्तीर्ण करण्याची दिनांक ३१.३.१९९६ ची मुदत या आदेशाद्वारे काढून टाकण्यात येत आहे.” हा शासन निर्णयाच्या परिच्छेद ७ (अ) मधील उल्लेख म्हणजे एमफक्टोने याबाबत घेतलेली भूमिका किती बिनचूक होती याचा पुरावाच आहे. तथापि तदर्थ स्वरूपाच्या नेमणुका देणे, सेवेत असलेल्या अधिव्याख्यात्यांना नेट सेट परीक्षा उत्तीर्ण होण्याची सक्ती करणे, न झाल्यास वार्षिक वेतनवाढ देण्यात न येणे, त्यांची सेवा वरिष्ठ व निवडश्रेणीसाठी विचारात न घेणे, सेवा जेष्ठता न देणे या शासन निर्णयातील अटी संपूर्णपणे समझोत्याच्या व विद्यापीठ अनुदान आयोगाच्या व केंद्र शासनांच्या सुचनांच्या विरुद्ध आहेत. त्यामुळे या अटी ताबडतोब मागे घेण्यात याव्या अशी मागणी ही सभा करित आहे.”

(७) मा. उच्च न्यायालयाच्या दिल्ली खंडपीठाने १३ मे १९९३ रोजी दिलेल्या निकालात (C.W.P.NO.3570 OF 1992 and C.M.NO.6675/92) “नेट सेट”ची पात्रता परीक्षा बंधनकारक आहे असा निर्णय दिला व त्यासोबतच “This will however, not apply to the appointments already made.” असेही स्पष्टपणे नमुद केले आहे. हायकोर्टाच्या उपरोक्त आदेशाबाबत “That order will continue to operate till the final disposal of this appeal” असा मा. सर्वोच्च न्यायालयाने १५ एप्रिल १९९४ रोजी निवाडा दिलेला आहे ही गोष्ट आपल्या लक्षात आणून देण्यात येत आहे.

(८) संदर्भ ६ वर नमुद केलेल्या विद्यापीठ अनुदान आयोगाच्या पत्रामध्ये अगदी सुरुवातीलाच पुढीलप्रमाणे उल्लेख आहे :- “In supersession of UGC Regulation No.F.1-11/87(CPP-II) dated 19th September,1991 and Notification No.F.3-1/94(PS) dated 24th December, 1998, the UGC has made the Regulations for minimum qualifications required for the appointment and career advancement of teachers in universities and institutions affiliated to it.” विद्यापीठ अनुदान आयोगाने याच पत्रासोबत पाठविलेल्या “UGC Regulations, 2000” च्या परिच्छेद २ च्या परंतुकामध्ये पुढीलप्रमाणे स्पष्ट उल्लेख आहे :- “Provided further that these regulations shall not be applicable to such cases where selections of the candidates having had the then requisite minimum qualification as were existing at that time through duly constituted Selection Committees for making appointments to the teaching posts have been made prior to the enforcement of these regulations.”

## UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION GUIDELINES FOR THE SCHEME OF TEACHER FELLOWSHIP FOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT-2000

### A. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

i) The Commission will provide assistance for award to teacher fellowships for professional development for doing M.Phil. or completing Ph.D. to the teachers of Universities/Colleges which are eligible to receive assistance under normal development schemes. A total of 15% and 7.5% fellowships will be reserved for SC and ST candidates respectively.

ii) A teacher Fellow will register for the M.Phil in College/University/Institution which offers the M.Phil programme in the concerned subject. A teacher fellow will register for research for completing his/her Ph.D. in a College/University/Institution having well developed Postgraduate Department in the concerned subject with adequate research facilities.

iii) The teacher will continue to receive full salary from the parent institution/College during the period of award of Teacher Fellowship.

Sub: Guidelines for the Scheme of Teacher Fellowship for Professional Development.

Sir,

To Provide more opportunities to the teachers for professional development, the UGC has modified its teachers fellowship scheme. The salient features of the new scheme are given below:-

- i. There will be no limit on the number of teachers who can avail of the Fellowship under scheme.
- ii. The teacher fellowship for Ph.D. programme would be for two years extendable to third year, if necessary. The contingency grant for the 3rd year shall however be Rs. 8000/-
- iii. The teacher fellowship for M.Phil. programme would be for one year extendable for another six months, if necessary.
- iv. The scheme will also be applicable to University teachers.
- v. The scheme will not be made applicable to the teachers who are entitled for Study leave with full pay. However, it would be open to them either to opt for the teachers fellowship or study leave.
- vi. Other rules/regulations parameters of the teacher fellowship scheme shall apply to this new scheme.

A copy of the revised guidelines for the scheme of Teacher Fellowship for Professional Development is enclosed for your information & necessary action. You are requested to bring this notice to the college affiliated to your University.

### B. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

i) The teacher should be permanent/confirmed (or have been appointed on regular basis in case of Government Colleges)

ii) The teacher should not be more than 45 years of age (relaxable by 5 years in case of women teachers and teachers belonging to SC/ST category) on the date of application.

iii) The teacher appointed upto 1986 should have at least a second class master's degree with minimum of 50% of marks (45% for SC/ST Teachers) and in case of teacher appointed after 1986 should have atleast 55% marks (50% in case of SC/ST teachers) at master level or equivalent in the seven point grading scale with letter grades. O,A,B,C,D,E and F.

iv) The teacher should have atleast three years of experience on the date of submission of application for award of teacher fellowship.

v) The teacher who did not avail any teacher fellowship from UGC or any other agency may be given preference.

vi) Teachers who are appointed as per UGC regulations of 1991 or have obtained relaxation from the UGC are eligible for the award of Teacher Fellowship during Ninth Plan Period.

### C. SELECTION COMMITTEE

a) Application for award of teacher fellowship in respect of a teacher will not be considered unless his/her case for such award is recommended through a Selection Committee to be constituted as under:-

- i) Vice-Chancellor of the University (in case of University teachers)/Principal of the College (in case of college teacher.
- ii) Head of the Department/A Senior Teacher of the subject concerned of the University/College.
- iii) A nominee of the University (in case of University teachers/affiliating university preferably the Director of the College Development Council; (in case of college teacher)
- iv) A subject expert from a teaching institution other than the concerned university/college.
- v) In case of selection of SC/ST candidate, a SC/ST person, preferably an academician in University, should also be present.

b) The Selection Committee will scrutinise the applications to be submitted in prescribed proforma (Appendix-I) in respect of the applications and ensure that the applicants satisfy all the conditions laid down by the Commission for the award of a teacher fellowship. A certificate to this effect will be furnished in the proceedings of the Selection Committee which will be signed by all the members.

c) The Selection Committee will prepare a panel of names of teachers to be awarded teacher fellowship in order of merit. While preparing the panel, care may be taken to select teachers from various disciplines. Separate panels will be provided for Humanities and Social Sciences and for Sciences.

#### D. AWARD OF TEACHERS FELLOWSHIPS

a) There will be no limit on the number of teachers who can avail of the Fellowship under the scheme. The shortlisting will be done at the University level keeping in view the availability of funds.

b) The teachers to be awarded teacher fellowships, including the duration of the award in person months in each case, will be communicated by the UGC main office for the University teachers and by the UGC Regional office under whose Jurisdiction the college falls, for the college teachers as indicated by the Vice Chancellor/Principal of the college and finalised by the Selection Committee.

c) The approval letters, relating to the award of teacher fellowships during the Ninth Plan Period, will be issued by the UGC main office for the university teachers and by the Regional Office under whose jurisdiction the college falls for the college teachers. The grants will be released by the UGC.

#### E. OTHER CONDITIONS

a) A teacher fellow may be permitted to do M.Phil. in the University/College in which he/she is employed that the University/College is running the M.Phil courses in the concerned subject. Also, a teacher fellow will be permitted to do research work leading to the Ph.D. in the University/College has Post-Graduate Courses in the concerned subject with adequate facilities for doing research.

b) The teacher fellowship for M.Phil programme would be one year extendable for another six month on the recommendation of Vice-Chancellor/Principal.

c) The tenure for teacher fellowship for Ph.D. shall be two years. The scheme will be extendable to third year on recommendations of the Vice-Chancellor/Principal if necessary. The contingency grants for third year shall however be Rs.8000/-.

d) The supervisor must give a report for progress in the mid-month of the period for which the fellowship is awarded. If the supervisor of the teacher fellow gives negative report, the award of teacher fellowship may be withdrawn by UGC.

e) The tenure of teacher fellowship for doing M.Phil or completing the Ph.D. should fall within the plan period and under no circumstances, can be extended beyond the Plan period i.e. beyond 31st March 2002. Hence, the selection for 2001-2002 will be completed before March 31st of the year 2001 and for the Ph.D. by March 31st of the year.

f) The scheme will also be applicable to university teachers.

g) The scheme will not be made applicable to the teachers who are entitled for study leave with full pay. However, it would be open to them either to opt for teachers fellowship or study leave.

#### F. RULES FOR LEA, CONTINGENCY, T.A. AND SALARY OF SUBSTITUTE

##### a. Living Expenses Allowances (LEA)

i) Living Expenses Allowance (a) Rs.1000/- per month, Will be paid to the teacher fellow with the effect from the date of joining the place of research. The tenure for teacher fellowship for Ph.D. shall be two years.

ii) Joining report (Appendix-ii) of the teacher fellow should be signed by him/her, his/her research guide, Head of the Department of the subject concerned and countersigned by the Head of the institution where the teacher fellow is registered for research.

##### b) Contingency Grants

i) A teacher fellow will be eligible to be reimbursed on actual by a contingency grant up to a limit of Rs.10,000/-. The accounts for contingency grant and Utilisation Certificate may be submitted to UGC main office for university teachers and to the UGC Regional Office under whose jurisdiction the college (parent institution) falls for the college teachers in the Prescribed Proforma (Appendix-iii), duly counter-signed by the Registrar/Head of the concerned University/Research Institute/Principal of the College where the Teacher Fellow is doing research work. The contingency grant for 3rd year shall however be Rs.8,000/-.

ii) Rules for leave and utilisation of Contingency Grant

## INCREASE IN LIFE MEMBERSHIP FEE

(A) The following Resolution was adopted by the General Body meeting of NUTA vide item No. 273, in its meeting held on 14 May, 2000.

**"That the life membership Fee of NUTA be increased from Rs. 2001 to Rs. 4001, With effect from 1st January 2001"**

(B) The provision in the Constitution of the Association is in para 3, which reads as follows :

"The Life Membership Fee may be increased at any time by a resolution passed by the General Body".

(C) The Executive Committee of NUTA at its meeting held on 16th July 2000 (Vide Item No. 39) resolved to approve the following arrangement :-

(1) From the date of the publication of this Bulletin till 31st December 2000 Life Membership Fee or the partial payment towards Life Membership Fee shall be accepted by the Treasurer only in the form of crossed Demand Draft. During this period, under no circumstances, the Treasurer will accept the Life Membership Fee by cheque or cash.

(2) However all Crossed Demand Drafts issued by any Scheduled Bank in Vidarbha on or before 31st December 2000 for Rs. 2001 or 1001 in favour of "TREASURER NUTA L.M. FUND" will be received by the Treasurer

and the said payment will be treated as a payment made by the concerned teacher towards Life Membership Fee of NUTA, as if paid on or before the date of implementation of the General Body Resolution.

(3) The Treasurer will issue receipt of such crossed Bank Draft and mention on each receipt name of the concerned teacher and the date on which such Bank Draft was issued and the name of the Bank concerned.

(4) Any teacher can become a member of NUTA by paying the L.M. Fee of Rs. 2001/- in one installment or in three installments. In the case of three installments, First installment of Rs. 1001/- must be paid by a crossed Bank Draft drawn in favour of "TREASURER NUTA L.M. FUND" on or before 31st December 2000.

(5) After paying the first installment, the teacher shall pay the remaining amount of Rs. 1000/- in two equal installments, before 31st December 2001.

(6) This facility of partial payment of the L.M. Fee of Rs 2001/- in three installments shall be available on or before 31st December 2000.

(7) If there is a failure in paying the total amount of L.M. fee of Rs. 2001 during the said period of one year i.e. before 31st December 2001 the partially paid installments shall be treated as donations.

**c. Travelling Allowance**

If the distance between the college (parent institution) and the research centre is not less than twenty kilometers and also if the research centre and the parent institution do not belong to the same city. The Teacher Fellow will be paid actual railway fare or bus fare or as per his/her entitlement according to college/university rules which ever is less, for joining the research centre and also for return to his/her parent institution after completion of the tenure of his/her award. The expenditure to be incurred in this regard is to be met out of the contingency grant.

**d. Salary of Substitute**

The salary of the substitute, appointed by the University/College in place of a teacher selected for award of teacher fellowship, will be admissible if fresh appointment is made by the University/College in accordance with the prescribed procedure on the minimum of the pay scale prescribed for the Lecturer or as per the background and experience of the teacher so appointed. The grant towards reimbursement of the salary of substitute teacher as per norms of UGC will be paid by the UGC and the balance amount may be met by the respective institute/college or by the respective State Government, wherever the substitute teacher appointed on higher pay than the minimum of lecturer pay-scale. If the post vacated by the teacher fellow is filled by transfer, deputation or by a superannuate person, such a substitute's salary will not be reimbursed. The substitute is to be appointed full time. The Commission will not pay the salary of the substitute of ap-

pointed on a part-time basis, unless there are substantial reasons for the same. The grant will be paid to the college for the salary of the substitute teacher on the receipt of the joining report of the Teacher Fellow along with the following information relating to the substitute teacher.

**G. RELEASE OF GRANT**

Grants towards contingency and Living Expenses Allowance (wherever applicable) for the teacher fellow and salary for the substitute (if appointed) will be paid to the University/College where the teacher was working immediately before joining as a teacher fellow.
