SECRETARY'S REPORT OF THE WORKING OF THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE YEAR ENDING ON 31st DECEMBER 2024

Prepared by the Executive Committee of NUTA under Article VI (b) (ii) of the Constitution of NUTA and Presented by the Secretary on behalf of the NUTA Executive Committee

Dear friends,

1. It gives me great pleasure to extend warm welcome to you on behalf of the Executive Committee of NUTA and on my personal behalf too. It is indeed a proud privilege to place before this august body a brief account of the activities and achievements during the year 2024.

2. Right from its commencement, NUTA has been committed to the welfare of the teaching community and their professional betterment. In keeping with the commitment, the association took up several issues concerning the teaching community during the period of this report which witnessed significant developments and had some major achievements. This particular year was again the year of continuous struggle for major issues.

3. Agitation Programmes against Higher Education Department Officials

In the year 2024, on 21st January, MFUCTO in its Executive meeting, held at Nashik passed resolution to Protest against the **“Indecent Behaviour of the Higher Education Department Officials of Continuously Disregarding the Judgments of Hon’ble High Court and Supreme Court”**. This agitation programme started from 29th January 2024 and continued till 30th April 2024 with different democratic action plan.

It is well-settled and absolutely accepted in Law that if any decision is given by the Hon’ble High Court or Hon’ble Supreme Court is not challenged formally then it becomes the law of the land. But, these two officers of Higher Education, instead of accepting and comprehending the orders of the court, have issued the orders which differ from the very decision of the Hon’ble Courts.

4. **CAS for M.Phil. Degree holders:** “Before July 2009, the teachers who have acquired the M.Phil. Degree, such teachers have to be given all other benefits along with the CAS from the first day of their appointment”. Such orders were passed by the Hon’ble High Court and the same decision was upheld by the Hon’ble Supreme Court. The Director, Higher Education in meeting with the MFUCTO delegation on 20th October 2023, was apprised with the above court orders, which he understood positively. Subsequently, he issued an order saying, “The teachers who acquired M.Phil. Degree in service, are entitled for the benefit of promotion under CAS from the date of holding the said qualification”.

The Deputy Secretary Higher Education was of the view that the Director Higher Education made a mistake in the above said order. In order to correct the orders issued by the Director, the Deputy Secretary Higher Education Ministry issued fresh order on 30th November 2023 in which it was mentioned, “If the teacher has acquired M.Phil. Degree in service, then taking into consideration the exemption given by the UGC, he will be entitled for the benefit of promotion under CAS, from the date on which the concerned teacher was exempted from passing the NET/SET examination”.

Now, while issuing these orders, the Director, Higher Education and the Deputy Secretary, Higher Education both had categorically ignored the exact sense of the order of the Hon’ble High Court and Supreme Court and again issued improper orders.

5. Composite scheme of UGC Regulations 2018:

The Hon’ble Supreme Court has recently passed an order regarding the violations of the UGC Regulations 2018 by the State Government of Gujarat regarding the appointments of the Vice Chancellor and Pro-Vice Chancellor. In para 15 of the Hon’ble Supreme Court order, it has been mentioned that, “UGC Regulations becomes part of the Act. In case of any conflict between State Legislation and Central Legislation, Central Legislation shall prevail by applying the rule/principle of repugnancy as enunciated in Article 254 of the Constitution as

the subject ‘education’ is in the Concurrent List (List III) of the Seventh Schedule of the Constitution.” The Hon’ble Supreme Court has also held that the eligibility criteria and appointment of Vice Chancellor shall always be as per the relevant UGC Regulations and the State Act if not on a par with the UGC Regulations must be amended to bring it on a par with the applicable UGC Regulations and until then it is the applicable UGC Regulations that shall prevail. In accordance with the above orders of the Hon’ble Supreme Court, Vice Chancellors from the state of Gujrat and Kerala were removed by their respective Governors.

In accordance with the above orders of the Hon’ble Supreme Court, the Governor of the State Maharashtra had issued the Ordinance regarding the appointments of the Vice Chancellor and Pro-Vice Chancellor in the State of Maharashtra, which has been also published in the Maharashtra Government Gazette on 11th January 2023. (Maharashtra Act No. VI of 2023). The Government Resolutions issued by the Department of Higher and Technical Education, Maharashtra Government on 8th March 2019, for implementing the UGC Regulations 2018 are in contradiction with the provisions made in UGC Regulations 2018. Only two provisions of the UGC Regulations were accepted by the Maharashtra Government by changing University Act. When the provisions of the UGC Regulations were not fully accepted, then the Government Resolution dated 8th March 2019 cannot be at par with the UGC Regulations and hence needs to be corrected. This responsibility of correction in GR lies with the Secretary, Higher Education and Director, Higher Education. But the same is not being done yet. These two cases (Para 3 & 4) have been cited here only as examples of indecent acts of the government officers. This agitation program stayed by the MFUCTO in-between due to the Code of Conduct declared for the Parliament Election in the nation as well as in the state of Maharashtra.

6. MFUCTO in its Executive meeting on 7th July 2024 held at University Campus Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune passed resolution and Demanded for strict action against **Higher Education Department Officials who misuse the provisions of the constitution by making ‘Insidious Changes’ without having any sort of amendments in the constitution.** This agitation program started from 15th July 2024 and continued till 17th August 2024 with different democratic action plan.

While there has been no change in Article 254 of the Constitution of India, the higher education department has used that article by changing it in an autocratic manner and it has been continuously used for their vested interest. In fact, the Hon’ble Supreme Court has defined the actual connotation of Article 254 of the Constitution. The law of the state government or the decision of the state government inconsistent with the regulation of the University Grants Commission cannot exist. This is the true sense of the Article. The Cabinet accepted it and made changes to remove the inconsistency in the state law and accepted the supremacy of the regulation, however, the officials of the higher education department are not ready to accept this decision of the Supreme Court and to amend the provisions of the government decision and they have continued the disdain.

Department of Higher Education disregarding many decisions of Hon’ble High Court and Supreme Court on large scale and it continues to do so, as in case, “Refund of 71 days of illegally deducted salary of the teachers and pay interest at the rate of 8% for late refund” such order passed by Hon’ble High Court and same decision confirmed by the Supreme Court. The Government of Maharashtra accepted the matter and accordingly issued a Government decision dated 7th December 2020. However, the Director of Higher Education, through an order dated 9 December 2020 to his Joint Directors, omitted the 8 percent interest component entirely. The Constitution of India gives the right to modify the decision of the High Court only to

the Supreme Court. In spite of this, Director took an erroneous liberty as if he had the power to amend the constitution. At the same time, without taking cognisance of the issue in its true spirit, the Director changed government decision. Therefore, the 8 percent interest amount has not been fully implemented.

Due to this insane behaviour of the Director of Higher Education, when the notice of contempt petition was issued to the Secretary of Higher Education, the Secretary reprimanded the Director and as a result, the Director of Higher Education again issued the order dated 17th October, 2022. While citing the decision of the High Court in his order, and for the first time in the history of Maharashtra, the unconstitutional practice of omitting the words of the decision of the Hon'ble High Court took place blatantly. They did not even realize that the constitution of this country does not give us the right to filter out the words of the Supreme Court decision while quoting it.

One of the Joint Directors of Higher Education granted stay to the order of Hon'ble High Court. The power to grant such stay/adjournment is vested only to the Hon. Supreme Court. Even though he is aware of this, he violated the authority of the Hon. Supreme Court. The Joint Director, being habituated with filing false affidavits before the Hon. High Court and the Supreme Court, can be said to be an unconstitutional and continuous act of the higher education department officials.

Former Legislative Council Member and Former President of MFUCTO and Senior Member of this Executive Body Prof. B.T. Deshmukh, on 24 June 2024, sent detail draft to Hon. Chief Minister and it was brought to his attention that in many cases, one after the other, the provisions of the constitution were violated in many indecent ways. In the same letter, he also requested the Hon. Chief Minister to discuss with the MFUCTO Executives, but no action was taken in this regard. However, this indecent way of flouting the provisions of the Constitution of India has gone beyond tolerance and has created an atmosphere of utter dissatisfaction in the higher education sector of Maharashtra and hence decision is being taken to protest strongly.

7. Status of High Court/Supreme Court Cases

Special Leave Petition (SLP) and Interim Application (I.A.) in Supreme Court about NET/ SET-affected Teachers the non-NET/SET teachers appointed between 1992 and 2000 are in the Supreme Court. The SLPs have been filed to get CAS benefits from the date of appointment and an Interim Application has been filed seeking implementation of the Supreme Court Interim Order issued in Asha Bidkar and others case, to this group of teachers. The compliance of the Supreme Court Registrar was made in respect of application filed by the group of organizations and AORs were informed for mentioning of the matters. Matter was heard on 18.09.2023 and order was passed: "Despite nodal counsels being appointed for completion of the house keeping task, the issue as to what should be the compilation has still not been resolved. When both the parties sign the memo that the compilation is ready, then Registry will list the matter for directions in 'miscellaneous matter'." Till the end of year 2023, single compilation was not submitted as per record of our counsel. As per the direction of court one compilation was submitted on 1st January 2024. Matter was called for hearing on 23.02.2024 and list appeals for hearing on 1st May 2024, Re-list the matters on 2nd May 2024, and pass order "It is brought to our notice that in some of the matters service is not complete. On taking steps by the appellants services be made effective." Re-list the matters after ensuing summer vacation. After summer vacation matters were called on for hearing on 25.07.2024, Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties have stated across the bar that they received the court list late in the evening, therefore, they could not prepare the case so Re-list the matter after two months. Matters were called for hearing on 23.10.2024 but on the request made by the learned senior counsel appearing for the state of Maharashtra the hearing was postponed to 22nd January 2025.

8. VII Pay Revision to Teachers in Social Work Colleges

A meeting of Social Work College teachers was organized at Shikshak Bhawan, Amravati on 3rd January 2021 wherein it was unanimously decided to approach the Hon'ble High Court with

a prayer clause to issue directions to the State Government to issue a GR regarding VII Pay Revision for Social Work College teachers. Accordingly, WP No. 2229 of 2021 was filed in the High Court at Nagpur Bench. The hearing was conducted through video conferencing. Notice was issued to the Government authorities for explanation. As the Government of Maharashtra had nothing to defend, it issued a GR No. Sakam 2019/C.R.81/Samasu dated 22nd October 2021 making applicable VII Pay Revision to the teaching and non-teaching staff of Social Work Colleges. But this GR too has certain anomalies. As the Government of Maharashtra has not filed any reply till date, the case is still pending in the High Court at Nagpur Bench.

9. Ph.D./M.Phil. Increments Case W.P.No. 4618 of 2021

Nagpur University Teachers Association have filed a civil WPN No. 4618 of 2021 seeking incentive in the form of advance increments for teachers with M.Phil./Ph.D. as per the UGC notification dated 18.07.2018 from the date of appointment/award. The case came for hearing before the Hon'ble Judges Sunil B. Shukre and Anil I. Pansare on 18th November 2021 wherein the Hon'ble Court issued notices to the parties concerned demanding explanation. Reply from the Government of Maharashtra was received on 19 December 2022. UGC reply is awaited, matter has not come on circulation in the year 2023. As per the direction of court once again notice was served to the UGC by hand on 30th April 2024. After completing the service, matter came for listing continuously from 15/07/2024 for 10-12 times throughout year 2024. Now the matter has been transferred to Bombay bench to tag with similar matter.

10. WP No. 3052 of 2016 (Regarding teachers who retired before 01.01.2006)

This WPN No. 3052 of 2016 was filed on 19th March 2016 regarding the fixation of the pay of the lecturers in the Selection Grade/Readers scale prior to 01.01.2006 who were entitled for revised pension; in no case shall be lower than fifty percent of the sum in the pay band and grade pay. Nine similar cases came to be clubbed together and few hearings have taken place. The last hearing took place on 22nd July 2021. Due to the outbreak of Covid-19, physical hearings could not take place in the matter. The matter came for hearing before the Hon'ble Judges Anil I. Pansare and Rohit Dev. After continuous hearing, the matter was closed for judgment on 30th August 2022, but now treated as not-part heard on 16.10.2023 State Government has sought time to engage senior counsel. Matter came for hearing on 21/03/2024, 01/04/2024 and 22/04/2024 and allow from petitioner's side. Government of Maharashtra did not comply the order and challenge the High Court order in Supreme Court on 03rd December 2024.

11. Social Work Colleges transfer to Department of Higher and Technical Education

The State Government took a decision to transfer the Colleges of social work under the purview of Social welfare Department to the Department of Higher and Technical Education of the State. The Government Resolution to this effect was issued on 29th February, 2024. NUTA had been demanding such transfer since 1980. Since some of the Colleges of social work were under the jurisdiction of the Department of Social Justice and special Assistance, the teachers and non-teaching staff were facing injustice and discrimination. The Association notes with satisfaction this decision which fulfills a long-pending demand.

12. MFUCTO Activities

* MFUCTO Executive meeting was held on 21st January 2024 at Nashik. In this meeting MFUCTO passed resolution against the indecent behaviour of the higher education department officials of continuously disregarding the judgments of Hon'ble Supreme Court and High Court in many cases. Decided 14 point agitation programme across the state with demand to fix responsibility on concerned officials.

* MFUCTO issued a letter to Director Higher Education and Secretary Higher Education Maharashtra State, Mumbai on 29/01/2024 along with MFUCTO resolution copy dt. 21/01/2024 by President and Secretary of MFUCTO.

* MFUCTO Executive meeting was held on 24th February

2024 at University Campus Savitibai Phule Pune University, Pune.

* MFUCTO General Body meeting was held on 25th February 2024 at University Campus Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune.

* MFUCTO Executive committee meeting was held on 16th June 2024 at Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University Campus, Amravati.

* MFUCTO Executive committee meeting was held on 7th July 2024 at University campus Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune

* MFUCTO President and Secretary wrote letter to Director Higher Education Maharashtra Government Pune regarding implementation of CAS to the teachers those (acquired) completed M.Phil. Degree.

* MFUCTO Executive meeting was held on 25th November 2024 at 6.30 pm on online mode.

13. AIFUCTO Activities

Dearness Relief Increase to 50% on Pension/Family Pension w.e.f. 1 st January, 2024.

Read - Government Resolution, Finance Department No.: DRP-2023/C.R 94/SER-4, dated 23.11.2023.

RESOLUTION

Government is pleased to decide that the rate of dearness relief with effect from 1st January, 2024 will be revised from 46% to 50% to the State Government pensioners /family pensioners on their Basic Pension/Family Pension. Revised dearness relief with arrears from 1st January 2024 will be payable in cash with pension / family pension of the month of July 2024.

2. It will be the responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority, i.e. the Pay and Accounts Officer, Mumbai/Treasury Officers, as the case may be, to calculate the quantum of dearness relief payable in each individual case.

3. Government is also pleased to direct that above decision should mutatis mutandis, apply to those pensioners including family pensioners of Recognised and Aided Educational Institutions, Agricultural / Non-Agricultural Universities and Affiliated Non-Government colleges to whom the pension scheme is made applicable.

4. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Section 248 of the Maharashtra Zilla Parishads and Panchayat Samitis Act, 1961 (Mah.V of 1962) and of all the other powers enabling it in

that behalf. Government is further pleased to decide that the above decision shall apply to the pensioners including family pensioners of Zilla Parishads.

5. The expenditure on this account should be debited to the Budget Heads to which the retirement benefits of the employees mentioned in the above paras are debited and should be met from the grants sanctioned thereunder.

6. All orders in force in regard to the payment of relief on pension sanctioned by Government from time to time will, mutatis mutandis, apply to the dearness relief now sanctioned.
